Materials: 40 Pennies. 20 Dimes. 1 Die.

Number of Players: 2 Players

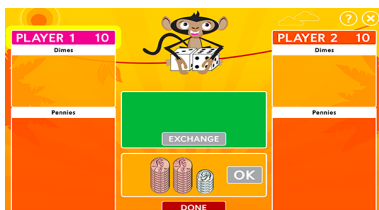
Directions:

Players take turns rolling the die and giving pennies equal to the amount on the die.

Players exchange 10 pennies for one dime.

After the first play with 10 dimes, for a second play is the

Penny Plate

Materials: 10 pennies. One plate.

Number of Players: 2 Players

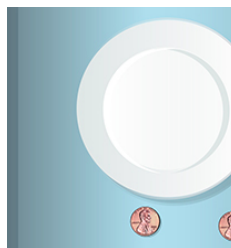
Directions:

1. Player 1 hides some of the 10 pennies under the plate with the remainder next to the plate.

2. Player 2 then counts how many pennies they can see next to the plate and uses that number to find how many pennies are hidden under the plate so the sum of the pennies equals 10.

3. You get a point for each correct answer.

Option: switch the player's roles and play again.



Fisted Penny Addition

Materials: 10 pennies.

Number of Players: 2 Players

Rules:
Player 1 divides the 10 pennies between two hands.
Player 1 then shows only one hand to Player 2.
Player 2 then counts how many pennies are in that hand and uses that number to find how many pennies are in the closed fist so that the total number of pennies equals 10.

Player 1 gets a point for a correct answer.
Player 1 then switches the roles and play
